Support Groups

C.A.R.E.S. (Compassion, Advocacy, Resources, Empowerment, Support) is a support group for families and friends with a loved one who is struggling with addiction, whether active or in recovery, as well as for those who have lost someone to addiction. The group meets from 6 to 7:30 p.m. on the 1st, 3rd, and 5th Wednesday at the NOM Center.

Family Connections is for kinship families who are raising children due to addiction. Kinship care is when children live with relatives, such as grandparents, aunts or uncles, adult siblings or other extended family members. The group offers free events every other month.

Fences and Bridges (F.a.B.) is a group for children ages 7-16 who have been affected by addiction. The goal of this club is to create a safe place for children facing daily challenges resulting from the loss of a loved one or a loved ones' struggle with addiction. The club provides an opportunity to meet other children who share similar experiences. We focus on activities that will build trust, self-esteem, and confidence, encourage positive decision making and explore emotions and feelings. Fences and Bridges is held the second Monday of each month from 6-8 p.m. at the Not One More Family Center, 1337 East Market Street. Dinner is provided at no cost for children and family members. Pre-registration is required.
